

Objectives

Delivery Methods

- Online Training (interactive online webinars)
- Interactive webinars as the main form of training delivery, for both training
 Units and both groups of participants
- Online training provided within Unit 1: Leadership, for both levels, consists of 1 session per training course of 2.5 hours total of 5 training course = 5 sessions
- Online training provided within Unit 2: Technical Knowledge, consists of 2 sessions per training course of 5 hours - total of 5 training course = 10 sessions
