









A New European Parliament 2019-2024





Identifying RD champions



- Mapping 112 MEPs so far (including 6 medical doctors, 3 former health ministers)
- 23 elected MEPs signed the Pledge4RD during elections (8 new and 15 returning)



Review of the Cross-border healthcare Directive by the ECA – JUNE 2019

The Commission should:


- (a) by 2023 assess the results of the rare disease strategy (including the role of ERNs) and decide whether this strategy needs to be updated, adapted or replaced;
- (b) by 2020 in consultation with MS set out ways forward to address the challenges faced by the ERNs (incl. integration of ERNs into national healthcare systems, and patients' registries);
- (c) by **2022** work towards a simpler structure for any future EU funding to the ERNs and reduce their administrative burden.
