
86 MEP candidates from 20 EU countries signed the pledge







Per country







EU elections : results

- The **EPP** scores a clear **victory**: 186 seats (+9)
- **S&D** remain **stable**: 135 seats (-2)
- Renew Europe decrease: 79 seats (-23)
- Far-right wins big : ECR : 73 (+4), ID: 58 (+9) + NA => 1/4 of the seats
- The **Greens decrease**: 53 seats (-19)
- The **left** remain **stable**: 36 seats (-1)





What to expect?

- Political fragmentation
- Uncertain coalitions (also depends on the FR elections results)
- 1/ Current coalition : EPP, S&D, RE
- 2/ Centre-right coalition : EPP, RE, ECR (+ ID ?)
- 3/ Centre-right coalition : EPP, S&D, RE, Greens



And for Rare diseases?

Deprioritisation of health at EU level both in priorities and budget:

- €1 billion reallocation from the health budget
- No return to Covid levels
- Absent from MS' priorities (June European Council)
- Rise of far-right puts health policies at risk
- Frank Vandenbroucke (BE) is favourite for Commissioner for health

- **Returning**: Metz (LU), Konecna (CZ), Gonzales Casares (ES), Wolken (DE), Solis Perez (ES), Knotek (CZ)
- **Leaving**: Kympouropoulos (GR), Colin-Osterlé and Amalric (FR), Cedras (PT), Ries (BE)
- Unknown: Sokol (HRV)
- New potential allies : please share your knowledge ©
