

WORKSHOP GUIDE: PATIENT INVOLVEMENT IN CLINICAL PRACTICE GUIDELINES WORKSHOP STRUCTURE

PREPARATION



Read the information factsheet for participants.

FIRST ROUND

Select the stage where you believe patient involvement is most relevant.

Collaborate with other participants who have selected the same stage to:

- Discuss who to involve.
- Determine what their involvement will achieve.
- Identify types of engagement.

Use the post-its to capture the discussion and your contributions. Feel free to move to another group and make additional contributions.

Debrief with all participants.



SECOND ROUND

Start the second round. Join a team and discuss patient involvement in 1 or 2 stages that were neglected during the first round.

- Identify activities that should normally be undertaken at this stage.
- Discuss how patient involvement can be enhanced at this stage through different activities.

Share with your team the answers in a post-it and reflect on the learnings from the activity.

Debrief with the other teams.
